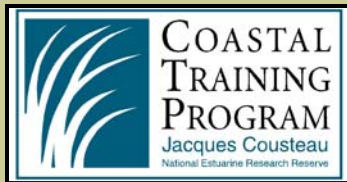

The rules were updated in 2007 in order to incorporate more stringent standards for development in flood hazard areas and riparian zones adjacent to surface waters throughout the State.



The Flood Hazard Control Act rules exist in order to:

- Better protect the public from the hazards of flooding,
- Preserve the quality of surface waters, and
- Protect the wildlife and vegetation that exist within and depend upon such areas for sustenance and habitat.
